WHAT IS A COMP PLAN?

- Captures community vision
- Brings direction, order, satisfies certain legal requirements
- Serves as a unifying overall plan
- Also referred to as a master plan, provides for the physical, social, economic, and environmental development of the municipality, including studies of land use, infrastructure, etc.
- Specific policies and implementation tools grow from the Comp Plan – zoning and development regulations, codes, standards, fiscal priorities
